Scoring	<p>Cheerleaders will be scored out of 10 in 10 different categories:</p> <p>Section 1 – Cheer & Chant - Groups will be judged on their voice projection, use of props, choreography.</p> <p>Section 2 – Stunts – Timing, stability, dismounts.</p> <p>Section 3 – Pyramids – Timing, stability, dismounts.</p> <p>Section 4 – Jumps – Execution, power, variety, landings.</p> <p>Section 5 – Tumbling – Execution, number of members participating.</p> <p>Section 6 – Dance – Energy, originality, execution.</p> <p>Section 7 – Arm motions – Sharpness, correct placing.</p> <p>Section 8 – Formations – Spacing, choreography.</p> <p>Section 9 – Synchronisation – Timing, unity.</p> <p>Section 10 – Expressions – Facial expression, confidence, performance.</p>
Cheer & chant	All schools will be responsible for creating their own cheer and chant. This should be around 30 seconds long and include school colours, school's motto and any inspiring quotes you use at school. Props such as pom poms, boards etc can also be used.
Awards	<p>Certificates for all participants.</p> <p>Medals for 1st, 2nd & 3rd in each category.</p> <p>Trophy for highest scoring team.</p>
